Fee - Send No Money with Application

Your new waiver will be in effect for 2 years; there is a biennial fee of \$180. Please send no money with your application; you will be billed.

If Your Agency Has Multiple Sites

As government labs engaged in limited public health testing, EIS counselors working for a single Community Service Board (CSB) may operate labs at multiple sites within the CSB under the same CLIA Waiver.

Renewing Your CLIA Waiver

Once you are in the system, you should receive a renewal fee coupon every 2 years. Your coupon should arrive by U.S. mail about 6 months prior to the expiration date.
